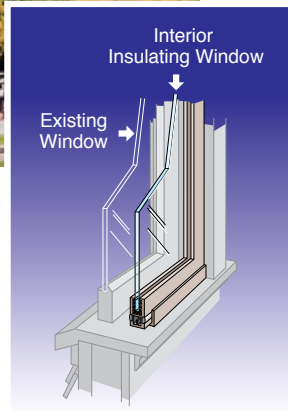
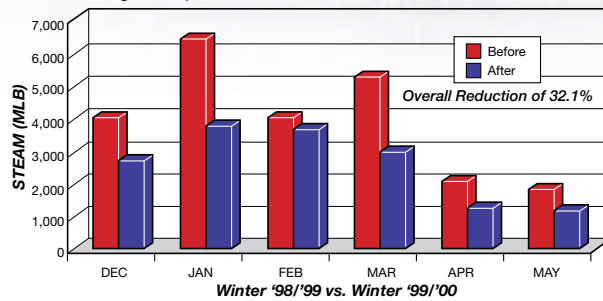
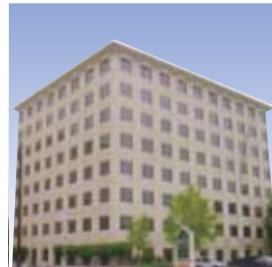


Over 4,800 windows in the Anthony J. Celebrezze Federal Building in Cleveland, OH have been retrofitted with an interior insulating add-on window product to increase energy efficiency. The new interior insulating units, an alternative to total window replacement, work with the building's existing windows to create a dual barrier against the elements. The added pane of glass resulted in a **first year energy savings of \$204,000**. Maine Glass was the contractor on the \$1.2 million project.

Maine Glass Interior Insulating Window

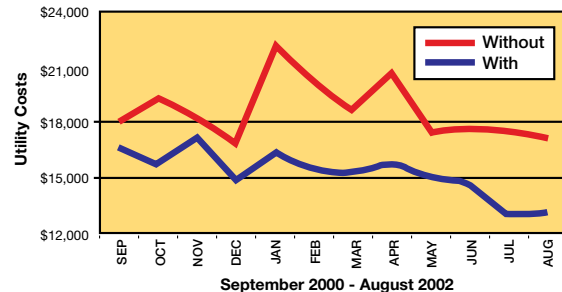

The Patrick V.
